History of WordPress




- 2003 Launch: Originally a blogging platform.

Open Source: Community-driven development.





Posts vs Pages

Posts: Time-sensitive content (blogs, news, articles). Pages: Static content (about us, contact).

Categories and Tags

Categories: Organize content into broad topics. Tags: Add specific keywords for detailed content sorting.



Comments Management

Engagement: Enable user feedback on posts.
Moderation: Control and respond to comments in the dashboard.

Dashboard Overview

Central Hub: Control site settings, content, and appearance. User-Friendly: Intuitive interface for easy navigation.

Media Library

Centralized Storage: Upload and manage images, videos, documents. Easy Integration: Seamlessly embed media into posts/pages.

User Roles and Permissions

Admin, Editor, Author, Contributor, Subscriber roles. Control Access: Define who can create, edit, and manage content.

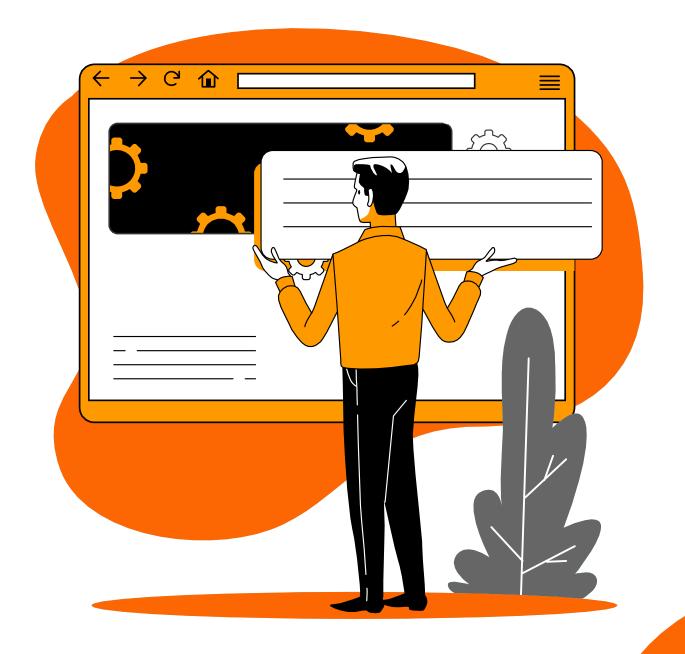
